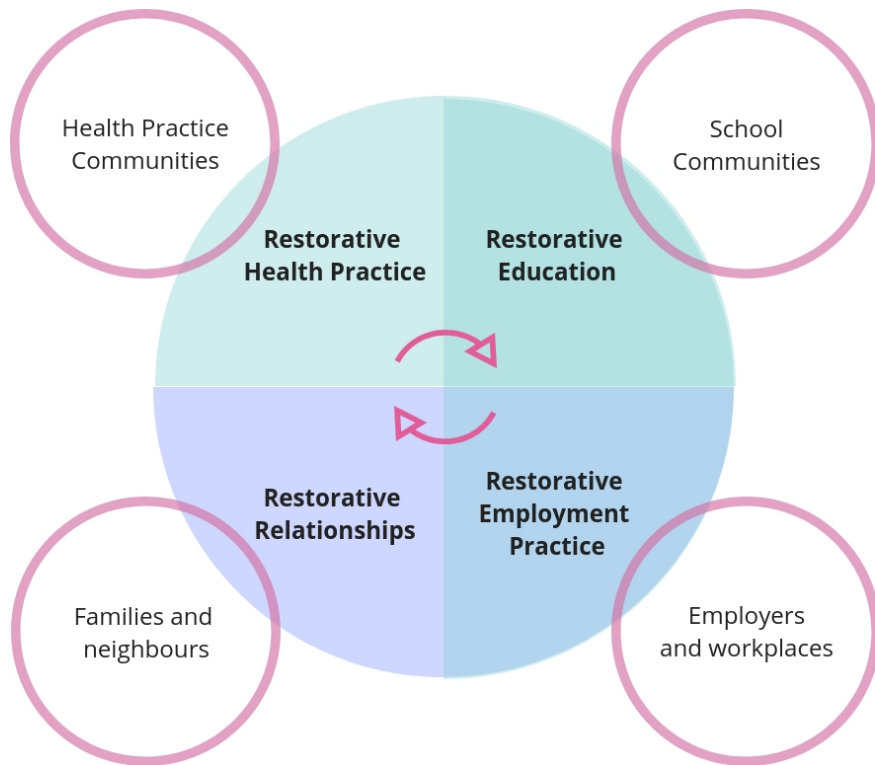


## Would you like to join Cornwall's Restorative Leadership Development Programme as part of your CPD and Objectives for 2018/19?
