RJ Working has allowed me to develop methodologies to create safe spaces for community members to express their needs

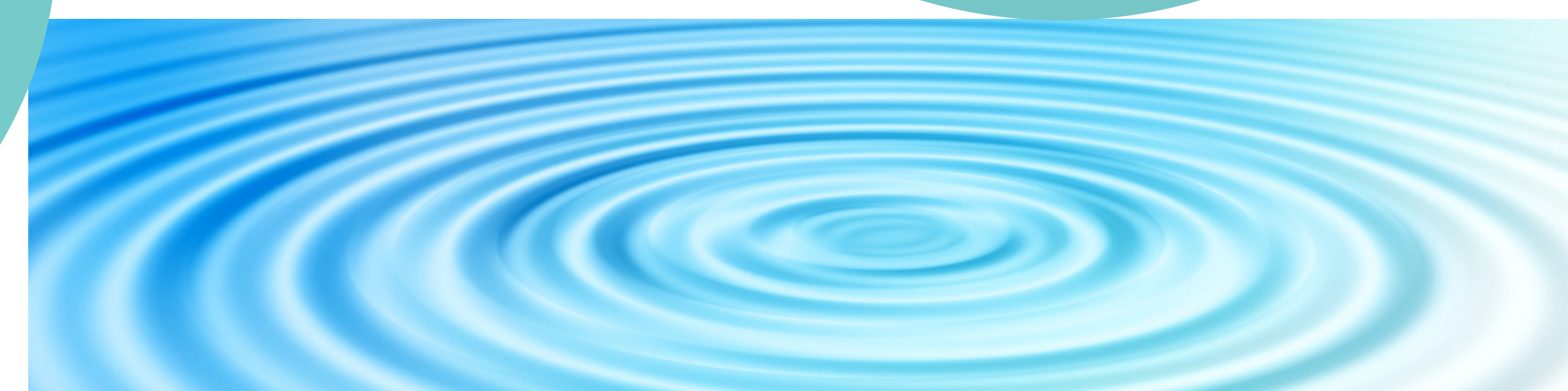
RJ Working has given a takeaway set of skills that I can begin to use in mt current work with young people already

Young People in the Lead

Of highest importance to RJ Working are collaborations with young people. We provide a Restorative framework, in which they co-create the content

Our Step-Up Programme is a proven success with children aged 9-11 enabling them to better look after themselves and each other.

Our Ripple Effect programme is for young people aged around 14 This is designed to promote social and emotional capabilities, especially mutual respect, shared responsibility and caring relationships.

Tackling Inequality

The Restorative model attends to hurt and harm rather than the rule that has been broken. So it contributes at a cultural level in response to cultural systemic harms. Fania Davis likens this to caring for the soil (culture) as well as the plants (individuals).
